STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED
FIFTY-THREE

AN ACT Prohibiting Live Entertainment on Licensed Liquor Premises.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows :

R. S., c. 57, § 37, repealed and replaced. Section 37 of chapter 57 of the revised statutes, as amended, is hereby repealed and the following enacted in place thereof:

‘Sec. 37. Prohibiting live entertainment on licensed premises. No licensee shall permit on the licensed premises, or premises contiguous or adjacent thereto, under his control, any live shows.’
