RESOLVE, Providing for Certain Construction at Monmouth Academy.

Monmouth academy; construction provided for. Resolved: That the sum of \$22,300 be, and hereby is, appropriated out of the unappropriated surplus of the general fund to

Finish off and equip the stage and 2 rooms at the side of the stage for classrooms;

Put in a ceiling and sheathe the walls of the building;

Provide bleachers and folding chairs necessary for the gymnasium and auditorium;

Build an addition on the front of the gymnasium to provide cloak rooms and toilet facilities for the public.

Put in ceilings and sheathe the basement rooms.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

The estimated cost to complete the building at Monmouth Academy for the above, is as follows:

For the 1st mentioned item:	\$ 4,000
For the 2nd mentioned item:	7,000
For the 3rd mentioned item:	5,500
For the 4th mentioned item:	5,000
For the 5th mentioned item:	800
