AN ACT Relating to Reimbursement of Bounty on Bears.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 33, § 103, amended. The last paragraph of section 103 of chapter 33 of the revised statutes, as revised, is hereby amended to read as follows:

'The bounty so paid by the town treasurer shall be reimbursed by the state out of the fees ~~for licenses for dogs~~ **from hunting licenses** upon presentation of the claim as hereinbefore set forth and any expense incurred by the department incident to the enforcement of this section, shall also be taken from the fees ~~for licenses for dogs~~ **from hunting licenses**, and so much of the fees received ~~for dog licenses~~ **from hunting licenses** as may be necessary to pay said bounties and any expenses incident thereto, is hereby appropriated to pay the same.'
