COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S. P. 248, L. D. 671, Bill, "An Act
Relating to Application for Writ of
Habeas Corpus."

Amend said bill by striking out the underlined words and
punctuation "in any county in the state, regardless where the
restraint may exist, and" in the 6th and 7th lines of said bill.

Further amend said bill by striking out the underlined
words and punctuation ". and a hearing shall be held by such
justice within 48 hours of the time of filing such application,
and judgment shall be rendered within 24 hours after hearing
thereon" in the 9th, 10th, 11th and 12th lines thereof.
