AN ACT Relating to Fire Wards.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows :

R. S., c. 85, § 21, amended. Section 21 of chapter 85 of the revised statutes is hereby amended by adding at the end thereof a new sentence to read as follows :

'When for any reason the office of fire ward is vacant or the fire ward is incapacitated, and there is no organized fire department, the municipal officers may appoint one or more fire wards who shall serve until the next ensuing election of officers.'
