STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-THREE

AN ACT Relating to Automobile Travel by State Fire Inspectors.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 14, § 28, amended. The 1st sentence of section 28 of chapter 14 of the revised statutes, as amended, is hereby repealed and the following enacted in place thereof:

'The state shall pay for the use of privately owned automobiles for travel by employees of the state in the business of the state not more than 7c per mile for the first 5,000 miles actually travelled by such employees on such business in any 1 fiscal year, and 6c for each mile exceeding 5,000 miles; provided, however, that the state shall pay inspectors of seed potatoes 8c for every mile so travelled.'
