SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to H. P. 676, L. D. 692, Bill "An Act
Relating to the Practice of Architecture."

Amend said Bill by striking out the underlined words
and punctuation "evaluations," in the 3rd line of the 2nd
paragraph of that part designated "Sec. 7-A" of section 1.

Further amend said Bill by striking out the underlined
subsection IV of the last paragraph of that part designated
"Sec. 8" of section 2 and inserting in place thereof the
following underlined subsection:

'IV. Any remodeling or alteration of existing
buildings not involving structural changes.'
