STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-THREE

AN ACT Relating to Charges for Medical Examination by Applicants for Employment.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 25, § 36-B, amended. Section 36-B of chapter 25 of the revised statutes, as enacted by chapter 394 of the public laws of 1949, is hereby amended to read as follows:

'Sec. 36-B. Charge for medical examination by employer prohibited. It shall be unlawful for any employer to require any employee or applicant for employment to bear the medical expense of an examination when such examination is ordered or required by the employer. Any employer who violates the provisions of this section shall be liable to a penalty of not more than \$50 for each and every violation. It shall be the duty of the commissioner of labor and industry to enforce the provisions of this section.'
