### AN ACT Relating to Damages to Poultry by Dogs.

Be in enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 88, § 17, amended. The last sentence of the 1st paragraph of section 17 of chapter 88 of the revised statutes, as amended, is hereby further amended to read as follows:

'When the claim is approved by the commissioner of agriculture or his duly authorized agent it shall be paid by the state to the person sustaining such damage out of the appropriation made by the legislature and if said damage was caused by dogs, shall be a proper charge against the fund received by the state under the provisions of section 10, otherwise it shall be a charge against the fund received by the state from hunting licenses.'
