SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to Senate Amendment "A" (L. D. 1550) to
H. P. 671, L. D. 714, Bill "An Act Relating
to Explosives."

Amend said Amendment by striking out the 5th underlined sentence of that part of section 1 designated "Sec. 41-A", which underlined sentence reads as follows: "For the purpose of reloading shells, a maximum quantity of 5 pounds of sporting or smokeless powders, in the original manufacturer's containers, may be kept by a person licensed to own or possess the same."

Further amend said Amendment in that part designated "Sec. 41-B" by inserting after the underlined word "include" in the last sentence the underlined words and punctuation 'crude petroleum,'
