**AN ACT Exempting Medication Used in Agricultural Production from  
Sales Tax.**

---

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

**R. S., c. 14-A, § 10, sub-§ VI, amended.** Subsection VI of section 10 of chapter 14-A of the revised statutes, as enacted by section 1 of chapter 250 of the public laws of 1951, is hereby amended to read as follows:

**'VI. Seed, feed, medication, fertilizer.** Sales of seed, feed, **medication** and fertilizer used in agricultural production and sales of bait to commercial fishermen.'
