AN ACT Relating to Salaries of Clerk of Courts and Treasurer, and Clerk Hire in Office of Treasurer, Kennebec County.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows :

Sec. 1. R. S., c. 79, § 114, amended. That part of section 114 of chapter 79 of the revised statutes, as amended, which relates to the salary of clerk of courts of Kennebec county, is hereby further amended to read as follows :

‘Kennebec, ~~\$2,800~~ \$3,100,’

Sec. 2. R. S., c. 79, § 146, amended. That part of section 146 of chapter 79 of the revised statutes, as amended, which relates to the salary of county treasurer of Kennebec county, is hereby further amended to read as follows :

‘Kennebec, ~~\$2,500~~ \$2,800,’

Sec. 3. R. S., c. 79, § 269, amended. That part of section 269 of chapter 79 of the revised statutes which relates to clerk hire in the office of county treasurer of Kennebec county is hereby amended to read as follows :

‘for clerks in the office of county treasurer, ~~\$300~~ \$500.’
