STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-THREE

RESOLVE, in Favor of Carroll L. McKusick, of Parkman.

Carroll L. McKusick; reimbursed. Resolved: That the sum of \$190 be, and hereby is, appropriated to be paid to Carroll L. McKusick, of Parkman, to reimburse him for services rendered as a member of the Maine School Building Authority in 1951 and 1952; payment to be made from the funds of the Maine School Building Authority.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

Carroll McKusick, as chairman of the legislative education committee of the 95th legislature, served as a member of the Maine School Building Authority. He attended 19 meetings of the Authority in 1951 and 1952. The law which created the Authority made no provision for the payment of the services of the chairman of the legislative education committee. This resolve is to reimburse Mr. McKusick for the 19 meetings at the rate of \$10 per meeting.
