## STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-THREE

AN ACT Relating to Manufacture of Non-Alcoholic Beverages.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 27, § 220, amended. The last sentence of section 220 of chapter 27 of the revised statutes is hereby amended to read as follows:

'The use of saccharine, salicylic acid, and sulphites or other artificial or non-nutritive sweetening agents in the manufacture of drink products and other non-alcoholic beverages is prohibited.'
