STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-THREE

RESOLVE, in Favor of the Town of Dixfield.

Town of Dixfield; appropriation for. Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated in favor of the town of Dixfield, the sum of \$15,000 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1954, to aid in the repair and construction of the road beginning at end of black road on the Dixfield-Canton road on the easterly side of the Androscoggin river and extending to the Dixfield-Canton town line; said sum to be taken from the general highway fund. Any unexpended balance shall not lapse but shall remain a continuing carrying account until the purposes of this resolve have been completed.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

This road connects Canton with Dixfield. It would be convenient for trucking and travel.
