STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-THREE

RESOLVE, in Favor of a New Road from Jackman to Holeb.

New road from Jackman to Holeb; appropriation for. Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated from the general highway fund the sum of \$310,000 in favor of a new road leading from Jackman to Holeb, a distance of approximately 14 miles; said sum to be expended under the supervision of the state highway commission. Any unexpended balance shall not lapse, but shall remain a continuing carrying account to carry out the purposes of this resolve.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

It is estimated that the cost of this road will be \$310,000. This is a road which is much needed.
