**RESOLVE, Appropriating Money for Repair and Maintenance of Bridge
Over Moose River.**

Bridge over Moose river; appropriation for. Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated the sum of \$25,000 from the general highway fund to repair and maintain the bridge over Moose river near its mouth in Township 2, Range 1, N. B. K. P., Rockwood Strip so called, in the county of Somerset. Any unexpended balance shall not lapse but shall remain a continuing carrying account to carry out the purposes of this resolve.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

The Moose River bridge was constructed under the supervision of the state highway commission in pursuance of chapter 164 of the resolves of 1913 and in pursuance of chapter 324 of the resolves of 1915. The expense of constructing this bridge was shared equally between the State of Maine and the Great Northern Paper Company. Since its construction in 1913, the expense of maintenance and repair has been borne by the Great Northern Paper Company. The bridge is now in need of substantial repairs in order that it may be safe for passage.
