AN ACT Relating to Application for Hunting Licenses.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 33, § 63-A, additional. Chapter 33 of the revised statutes, as revised, is hereby amended by adding thereto a new section to be numbered 63-A, to read as follows:

'Sec. 63-A. Application for hunting license. Each applicant for a hunting license shall certify, on forms to be furnished by the commissioner of inland fisheries and game, that he is mentally and physically fit to carry and use firearms. Any person who falsifies such certification shall be permanently refused a hunting license.'
