**AN ACT Relating to Wearing Red Material While Hunting.**

---

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

**R. S., c. 33, § 64-A, additional.** Chapter 33 of the revised statutes, as revised, is hereby amended by adding thereto a new section to be numbered 64-A, to read as follows:

**'Sec. 64-A. Cape of red material. No person shall hunt without wearing a cape of red gantron material covering at least 1/3rd of the upper body from the shoulders to the hips.'**
