RESOLVE, Regulating Fishing in Chain of Ponds, Franklin County.

Opening Chain of Ponds for trolling. Resolved: That the commissioner of inland fisheries and game be, and hereby is, authorized and directed to issue a rule and regulation to open Chain of Ponds, situated in Chain of Ponds township, county of Franklin, for trolling with one single hook on a line and with anything for bait except fish, with a daily bag limit of 6 fish or 4 pounds, per person.
