**RESOLVE, Opening Kennebago Stream or River, Franklin County, to
Fly Fishing.**

Kennebago stream or river; opened to fly fishing. Resolved: That the commissioner of inland fisheries and game be, and hereby is, authorized and directed to issue a rule and regulation opening Kennebago stream or river, Franklin county, at the outlet of Kennebago lake from the Brown Company bridge to the first or upper dam, to fly fishing only until September 30th of each year with a daily limit of 6 fish or 5 pounds per person.
