**AN ACT Relating to Recording of Contracts for Conditional Sale of
Railroad Equipment.**

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. R. S., c. 42, § 99, sub-§ II, amended. Subsection II of section 99 of chapter 42 of the revised statutes is hereby amended to read as follows:

'II. Such instrument shall be filed for record in the office of the secretary of state **or with the interstate commerce commission pursuant to the provisions of the interstate commerce act;**

Sec. 2. R. S., c. 42, § 100, amended. Section 100 of chapter 42 of the revised statutes is hereby amended by adding at the end thereof the following sentence:

'The provisions of this section shall not apply if such contracts are filed with the interstate commerce commission pursuant to the provisions of subsection II of section 99.'
