STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-THREE

RESOLVE, in Favor of Nellie K. Freeman of Kittery.

Nellie K. Freeman; retirement credit. Resolved: That Nellie K. Freeman, of Kittery, be given credit for 21 years prior teaching service, and that said prior service credit shall be added to any other teaching service in the state of Maine for the purposes of determining final retirement benefits under the provisions of chapter 60 of the revised statutes.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

Mrs. Freeman taught in the public schools of Maine in the towns of Eliot and Dayton for 14 years. She had prior teaching experience in Massachusetts for 21 years. She receives a retirement from Maine to the extent of \$32.15 per month which is insufficient to maintain her.
