STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-THREE

AN ACT to Clarify Issuance of Harness Horse Racing Licenses.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 77, § 12, amended. The 1st and 2nd sentences of the next to last paragraph of section 12 of chapter 77 of the revised statutes, as enacted by section 5 of chapter 388 of the public laws of 1949, are hereby amended to read as follows:

'Notwithstanding anything in this chapter to the contrary, the commission $\frac{1}{2}$ may issue a license, where pari mutuel betting is permitted, to hold night harness races or meets for a period of 8 weeks and no more between June 15th and October 15th of each year, daily except Sundays, between the hours of 6 P. M. and midnight. The commission shall may grant such licenses for night harness racing to such applicants only, who shall have and maintain adequate pari mutuel facilities, which facilities shall include a totalizer or its equivalent where odds will change at least once every 2 minutes, adequate stable facilities for not less than 400 horses, and shall have and maintain a track adequate in width to start 8 horses abreast.'
