## STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-THREE

RESOLVE, Regulating Fishing in Pushaw Pond in the County of Penobscot.

Fishing in Pushaw pond, regulated. Resolved: That the commissioner of inland fisheries and game be, and hereby is, authorized and directed to issue a rule and regulation establishing a daily limit of 5 pickerel per person per day taken through the ice from the waters of Pushaw pond in Glenburn, Orono, Oldtown and Hudson, in the county of Penobscot.
