## STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-THREE

AN ACT Amending the Maine Employment Security Law as to Employer's Experience Classifications.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

- R. S., c. 24, § 17, sub-§ IV, ¶ C, amended. Paragraph C of sub-section IV of section 17 of chapter 24 of the revised statutes, as repealed and replaced by section 1 of chapter 430 of the public laws of 1949, is hereby amended to read as follows:
  - 'C. Any employer who under the provisions of this chapter would otherwise be entitled to a rate of less than 2.7% shall nevertheless pay a rate of 2.7% the next higher rate of contributions than that to which he was entitled for any quarter with respect to which he was in arrears in the payment of contributions or interest, unless the delay was occasioned by the illness or death of the person in charge of the records of the employing unit or by other unavoidable accident which shall excuse the employing unit from said penalty.'
