HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to H. P. 755, L. D. 780, Bill "An Act Amending the Maine Employment Security Law as to Definition of Employing Unit."

Amend said Bill by adding at the end of the Title thereof the words and Employer.

Further amend said Bill by inserting at the beginning of the 1st line thereof the underlined abbreviation and figure !Sec. 1.:.

Further amend said Bill by adding at the end thereof the following:

"Sec. 2. R. S., c. 24, 33. sub-\$IX. A, amended. Paragraph A of subsection IX of section 3 of chapter 24 of the revised statutes, as repealed and replaced by section 1 of chapter 430 of the public laws of 1949, is hereby amended to read as follows:

Any employing unit which for some portion of a day, but not necessarily simultaneously, in each of 20 different weeks, whether or not such weeks are or were consecutive, within either the current or the preceding calendar year, has or had in employment 8 4 or more individuals, irrespective of whether the same individuals are or were employed in each such day: "
