**RESOLVE, Closing Upper Churchill Stream in Somerset County to All
Fishing.**

Upper Churchill stream closed to fishing. Resolved: That the commissioner of inland fisheries and game be, and hereby is, authorized and directed to issue a rule and regulation to close Upper Churchill stream in Bald Mt. township and Moose River township, Somerset county, above the southern boundary line of Moose River township to all fishing.
