STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-THREE

AN ACT Designating Fluorosis and Fluoride Poisoning as an Occupational Disease.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 26, § 69, amended. Section 69 of chapter 26 of the revised statutes, as enacted by chapter 338 of the public laws of 1945, as amended by section 1 of chapter 261 of the public laws of 1951, is hereby further amended by adding at the end thereof the following:

'15. Fluorosis; Fluoride Poisoning or its Sequelae. 15. Any process involving direct exposure to fluorides.'
