## STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-THREE

#### AN ACT Relating to Medical and Legal Expenses Under Workmen's Compensation Law.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. R. S., c. 26, §22, amended. The 1st paragraph of section 22 of chapter 26 of the revised statutes is hereby repealed and the following paragraph enacted in place thereof:

'Every employee shall after injury be permitted to select any physician or surgeon authorized to practice as such under the laws of Maine and any attorney authorized to practice as such under the laws of Maine for examination and legal counsel. The services of such physician and attorney shall be paid for by the employer.'
