STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-THREE

AN ACT Relating to Renewal of Licenses for Barbering, Hairdressing and Beauty Culture.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 22, § 209, amended. The 3rd paragraph of section 209 of chapter 22 of the revised statutes is hereby amended to read as follows:

'No person, firm or corporation shall operate or cause to be operated a shop as establishment where barbering or hairdressing and beauty culture are practiced unless such shop or establishment has been duly licensed. The fee for a license to operate a barber shop shall be \$5 in the first instance and \$3 for each yearly renewal thereof. The license shall run from the 1st day of January in each year for 1 year and the fee shall be payable to the secretary of the board. The fee for a license to operate a beauty shop shall be \$5 in the first instance and \$3 **but not exceeding \$5**, for each yearly renewal thereof.'
