FIFTY-THREE

AN ACT Relating to Requirements for Registration for Hairdressing
and Beauty Culture.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 22, § 212, sub-§ I, amended. Subsection I of section 212 of chapter 22 of the revised statutes is hereby amended to read as follows:

'I. Who is at least 18 years of age, or who is otherwise qualified under the provisions of sections 205 to 222, inclusive;'
