STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-THREE

AN ACT Relating to Salaries of Sea and Shore Fisheries Coastal Wardens.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. R. S., c. 34, § 9-A, additional. Chapter 34 of the revised statutes, as revised, is hereby amended by adding thereto a new section to be numbered 9-A, to read as follows:

'Sec. 9-A. Compensation. The compensation of the sea and shore fisheries wardens shall be determined as follows:

On appointment as a coastal warden the warden shall receive a salary of \$53 per week during the 1st year of service; during the 2nd year of service he shall receive a salary of \$57 per week; during the 3rd year of service he shall receive a salary of \$60 per week; during the 4th year of service he shall receive a salary of \$63 per week; during the 5th year of service and thereafter he shall receive a salary of \$66 per week.

On appointment as a warden supervisor the supervisor shall receive a salary of \$72 per week during the 1st year of service; during the 2nd year of service he shall receive a salary of \$75 per week; during the 3rd year of service he shall receive a salary of \$78 per week; during the 4th year of service he shall receive a salary of \$81 per week; during the 5th year of service and thereafter he shall receive a salary of \$85 per week.

On appointment as a chief warden the chief shall receive a salary of \$86 per week during the 1st year of service; during the 2nd year of service he shall receive a salary of \$90 per week; during the 3rd year of service he shall receive a salary of \$94 per week; during the 4th year of service he shall receive a salary of \$98 per week; during the 5th year of service and thereafter he shall receive a salary of \$102 per week.

On appointment as boat captain the captain shall receive a salary of \$73 per week during the 1st year of service; during the 2nd year of service he shall receive a salary of \$77 per week; during the 3rd year of service he shall receive a salary of \$81 per week; during the 4th year of service and thereafter he shall receive a salary of \$85 per week.'

Sec. 2. Effective date. The provisions of this act shall be retroactive to January 1, 1953.
