HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to H. P. 768, L. D. 803, Bill, "An Act relating
to Registration Fees for Farm Trucks."

Amend said Bill by inserting at the beginning of the 1st
line the underlined abbreviation and figure 'Sec. 1.'

Further amend said Bill by striking out everything after
the amending clause and inserting in place thereof the following:

"Provided that the annual registration fee of farm
trucks not for hire of a total gross weight not exceeding 16,000
pounds, when such truck is used only for the transportation of
agricultural commodities or farm supplies to be used in connection
with the operation of a farm or farms owned, operated or occupied
by the registrant, shall be \$40."

Further amend said Bill by adding at the end thereof the
following:

'Sec. 2. Effective date. The provisions of this act shall
become effective on January 1, 1954.'
