AN ACT Relating to Registration Fees for Farm Trucks.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 19, § 18, amended. Section 18 of chapter 19 of the revised statutes, as amended, is hereby further amended by adding after the 1st paragraph thereof, the following:

'Provided that the annual fee for registration of farm motor trucks of not more than 16,000 pounds gross weight shall be as follows:

From 0 pounds gross weight to 11,000 pounds gross weight \$15

From 11,001 pounds gross weight to 16,000 pounds gross weight \$30. Such farm motor trucks shall be used only for the transportation of agricultural products produced on, and meant to be used in connection with the operation of a farm or farms owned, operated or occupied by the registrant. Such farm motor trucks shall not be used for the transportation of wood and lumber for sale other than from such farms on which the production of wood and lumber is incidental to other farm operations, nor shall such trucks be used for the retail delivery of milk. In the event that such a farm motor truck is thereafter registered for general use during the same registration year such fee shall be applied toward the fee for such general registration.'
