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**AN ACT Relating to Inspection of Boilers.**

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Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows :

R. S., c. 25, § 59-A, additional. Chapter 25 of the revised statutes, as amended, is hereby further amended by adding thereto a new section to be numbered 59-A, to read as follows :

‘Sec. 59-A. Temporary inspection certificates. Whenever it shall appear to the commissioner that an emergency affecting public safety and welfare exists, the commissioner may authorize the chief inspector, a deputy inspector or a special inspector to issue a temporary inspection certificate for a period not exceeding 6 months after an inspection certificate shall have expired. A temporary inspection certificate may be issued without an internal inspection being made; provided, if the boiler is insured, the temporary inspection certificate shall be signed by the special inspector of the company insuring the boiler and by the chief inspector, or one of his deputies; or, if the boiler is not insured, the temporary inspection certificate shall be signed by at least 2 authorized state inspectors. The provisions as to posting of the inspection certificate shall apply to the temporary inspection certificate.’
