STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-THREE

AN ACT Amending the Charter of the Maine School for the Deaf.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

- P. & S. L., 1897, c. 446, § 2, amended. Section 2 of chapter 446 of the private and special laws of 1897 is hereby amended to read as follows:
- 'Sec. 2. Location; state may accept conveyance of lot and buildings. Said school shall be located at Portland in the county of Cumberland, and the governor and council are hereby authorized, on behalf of the state, to accept a conveyance from the city of Portland of the school lot, building and fixtures now used as a school for the deaf in said Portland upon the condition that the state shall hereafter assume the entire charge, responsibility and expense of maintaining said school.'
