IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-THREE

AN ACT Providing Penalty for Dog Hunting Wild Animals.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 33, § 86, amended. Section 86 of chapter 33 of the revised statutes, as revised, is hereby amended by adding at the end thereof a new paragraph to read as follows:

'The owner or keeper of any dog violating the provisions of this section shall be punished by a fine of \$25 and such fine shall not be suspended.'
