RESOLVE, Permitting Sugar Loaf Ski Club to Use Certain State Lands.

Sugar Loaf Mountain ski club authorized to use certain lands. Resolved: That the Sugar Loaf Mountain ski club be permitted, with the approval of the forest commissioner, to use lands reserved for public uses adjacent to Sugar Loaf Mountain, Franklin county, for the purpose of obtaining soil therefrom to improve the terrain leading to Sugar Loaf Mountain.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

Sugar Loaf Mountain is being developed as a ski area and dirt, gravel, etc. are necessary to improve the approaches thereto.
