SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to S. P. 290, L. D. 825, Bill, "An Act Relating to Inspections by the Insurance Commissioner."

Amend said Bill by striking out all after the enacting clause and inserting in place thereof the following:

"<u>R. S., c. 122, §21, amended.</u> The 1st sentence of section 21 of chapter 122 of the revised statutes, as amended, is hereby further amended to read as follows: 'Whoever assaults, intimidates or in any manner wilfully obstructs, intimidates or hinders any sheriff, deputy sheriff, constable, inland fish and game warden, coastal warden, <u>insurance commissioner or his authorized representative,</u> liquor inspector or police officer while in the lawful discharge of his official duties, whether with or without process, shall be punished by a fine of not more than \$500, or by imprisonment for not more than 11 months.!"
