STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-THREE

AN ACT Relating to Compensation for Members of Maine Turnpike Authority.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

P. & S. L., 1941, c. 69, § 4, sub-§ (b), amended. The next to last sentence of subsection (b) of section 4 of chapter 69 of the private and special laws of 1941 is hereby amended to read as follows:

'Each member of the authority shall receive \$20 for each day in attendance at an official meeting and be reimbursed for necessary expenses incurred in the performance of his duties.'
