AN ACT Relating to Circuses and Travelling Amusement Shows.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows :

R. S., c. 88, § 53, amended. Section 53 of chapter 88 of the revised statutes, as amended, is hereby further amended by inserting after the 1st paragraph thereof a new paragraph, to read as follows :

‘The license shall be further conditioned that there shall be no display of advertising of licensee’s circus or travelling amusement show contrary to the provisions of sections 111, 112 and 122-B of chapter 20, and section 34 of chapter 118, relating to outdoor advertising; that the licensee shall at all times and at least once each week keep the commissioner informed of proposed changes in itinerary or location; and that the licensee shall conform to all lawful rules and regulations promulgated by the insurance commissioner relating to circuses and travelling amusement shows. Breach of any condition in the license shall be a cause for immediate suspension or revocation of the license, in the discretion of the commissioner.’
