STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-THREE

AN ACT to Increase the Salary of the Judge of the Waterville Municipal Court.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

P. & S. L., 1897, c. 325, § 3, amended. Section 3 of chapter 325 of the private and special laws of 1897, as amended by chapter 98 of the private and special laws of 1949, is hereby further amended to read as follows:

'Sec. 3. Judge, salary; clerical assistance. Said court shall consist of r judge, to be appointed in the manner and for the term provided by the constitution, who shall be a member of the bar in Kennebec county, who shall reside during his continuance in office in said city of Waterville, and who shall receive from said city, in monthly payments, an annual salary of $\frac{2}{2,100}$ \$3,000, which shall be in full for all fees pertaining to his office; provided, however, that he shall receive in addition to said salary all fees allowed by law in matters relating to civil business; and he shall have the authority to employ such clerical assistance as is necessary, and the city shall pay therefor in the same manner as the salary of the judge is paid.'
