# STATE OF MAINE

### IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-THREE

#### AN ACT Relating to Number of Medical Examiners for Cumberland County.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

**R. S., c. 79, § 258, amended.** The 3rd sentence of section 258 of chapter 79 of the revised statutes, as amended, is hereby further amended to read as follows:

'The number of medical examiners so to be appointed shall be as follows: for the counties of Franklin, Knox, Lincoln, Piscataquis, Sagadahoc, Somerset and Waldo, 2 each; for the counties of Hancock, Oxford and Washington, 3 each; for the counties of Kennebec and York, 4 each; for the counties of Androscoggin and Aroostook, 5 each; and for the counties county of Cumberland and Penobscot, 6 each; and for the county of Cumberland, 8; and they shall be appointed with reference to territorial distribution.'
