**AN ACT Relating to Number of Medical Examiners for Cumberland
County.**

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 79, § 258, amended. The 3rd sentence of section 258 of chapter 79 of the revised statutes, as amended, is hereby further amended to read as follows:

‘The number of medical examiners so to be appointed shall be as follows: for the counties of Franklin, Knox, Lincoln, Piscataquis, Sagadahoc, Somerset and Waldo, 2 each; for the counties of Hancock, Oxford and Washington, 3 each; for the counties of Kennebec and York, 4 each; for the counties of Androscoggin and Aroostook, 5 each; ~~and for the counties~~ **county** of ~~Cumberland and Penobscot, 6 each; and for the county of Cumberland, 8;~~ **Cumberland, 8;** and they shall be appointed with reference to territorial distribution.’
