**AN ACT Relating to Penalty for Carelessly Shooting Humans While  
Hunting.**

---

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

**R. S., c. 33, § 125, amended.** The 1st sentence of section 125 of chapter 33 of the revised statutes, as revised, is hereby amended to read as follows:

'Whoever while on a hunting trip, or in the pursuit of wild game or game birds, negligently or carelessly shoots and wounds, or kills any human being, shall be punished by ~~a fine of not more than \$1,000, or by imprisonment for not more than 10 years~~ imprisonment for 6 months, which punishment shall not be suspended.'
