STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-THREE

AN ACT Relating to Actions in Which Trustee Process May be Used.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 101, § 1, amended. Section 1 of chapter 101 of the revised statutes is hereby amended by adding at the end thereof the following sentence:

'But no original action shall be commenced by trustee process wherein the wages of the defendant, due to him for his personal labor, are attached; but any action, brought on a judgment previously rendered for any cause except those hereinbefore excepted, may be commenced by trustee process and attachment of wages.'
