AN ACT Relating to Powers of Recorder of Bath Municipal Court.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

P. & S. L., 1937, c. 64, amended. That part designated 'Sec. 17.' of chapter 64 of the private and special laws of 1937, as amended, is hereby repealed and the following enacted in place thereof:

'Sec. 17. Duties of recorder. The recorder shall be a justice of the peace for said county; and in the case of the absence, sickness or disqualification of the judge, or in the event of a vacancy in the office of judge, or at any other time at the request of said judge in order to expedite business, the recorder shall have the same powers as the judge.'
