STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-THREE

AN ACT Relating to Fees of Plumbers.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. R. S., c. 22, § 178, amended. Section 178 of chapter 22 of the revised statutes is hereby amended to read as follows:

'Sec. 178. Renewal of licenses; master plumbers. All licenses issued as aforesaid shall expire on the last day of the calendar year in which issued, and they may be renewed thereafter for periods of I year without further examination on payment of a fee of \$10 \$20 for each year for a master plumber. Any master plumber who fails to renew his license during any fiscal year, in subsequent years may renew his license only after payment of all unpaid renewal fees.'

Sec. 2. R. S., c. 22, § 179, amended. Section 179 of chapter 22 of the revised statutes is hereby amended to read as follows:

'Sec. 179. Renewal of licenses; journeymen plumbers. All licenses issued as aforesaid shall expire on the last day of the calendar year in which issued, and they may be renewed thereafter for periods of I year without further examination on payment of a fee of \$1.50 \$3 for each year for a

journeyman plumber. Any journeyman plumber who fails to renew his license during any fiscal year, in subsequent years may renew his license only after payment of all unpaid renewal fees.'
