STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED
FIFTY-THREE

AN ACT Relating to Exemptions from Regulation of Motor Carriers.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 44, § 27, sub-§ I, ¶ E, amended. Paragraph E of subsection I of section 27 of chapter 44 of the revised statutes, as amended, is hereby further amended by adding at the end thereof the following:

‘provided, however, that any person, firm or corporation who transports said wood, pulpwood, logs or sawed lumber, (including horses, crew, equipment and supplies) beyond said 60 mile limit, either between points within, or between points within and without the state of Maine, shall forfeit this exemption;’
